---



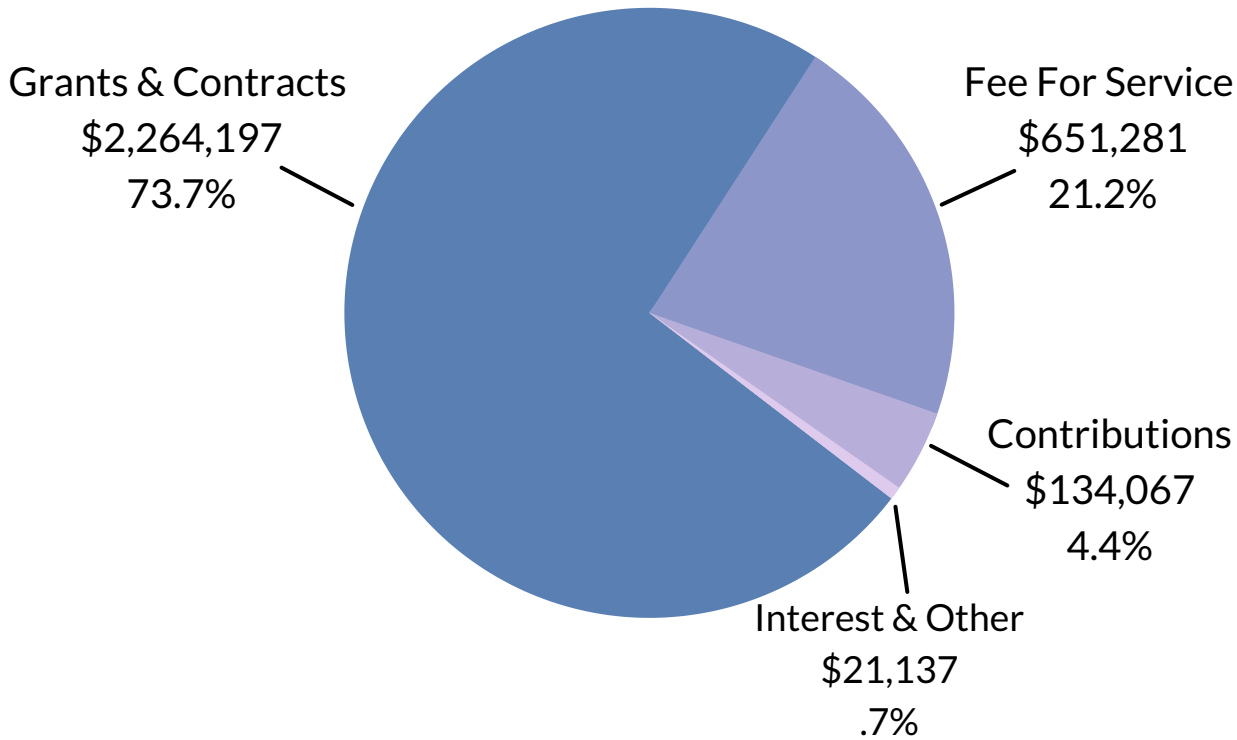

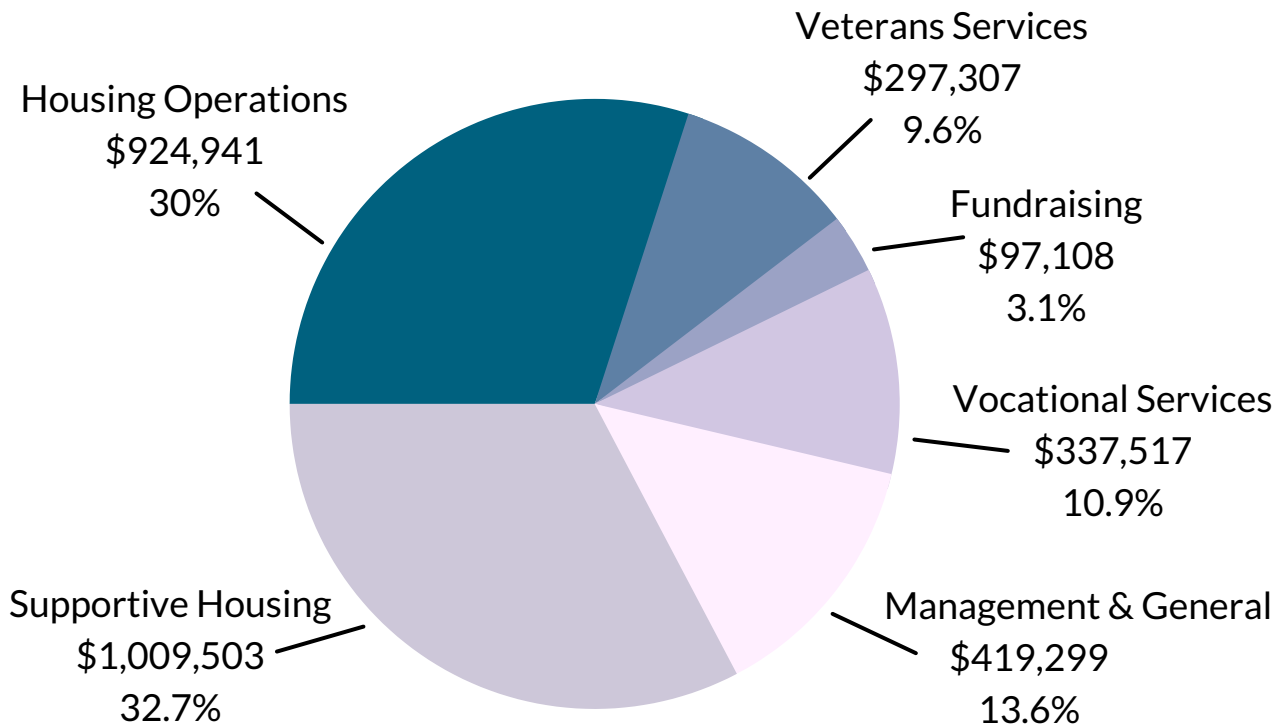
# FINANCES
